

Biography of Dr. James Quigley

Dr. Jim Quigley is a calf nutrition scientist, educator, and consultant with more than 30 years of experience in calf health, nutrition, and management. He earned his B.S. and M.S. from the University of New Hampshire and his Ph.D. from Virginia Tech.

Over the course of his career, Dr. Quigley has held a range of academic and industry leadership roles. He served as an Associate Professor at the University of Tennessee and later held executive positions in the animal nutrition industry, including Vice President for Research at Diamond V Mills and Vice President and Director of Calf Operations at APC, Inc.. He has also provided global technical leadership in calf and heifer nutrition, supporting dairy operations and industry partners around the world.

Dr. Quigley is widely recognized as a leading authority in calf biology and management. He has authored more than 110 peer-reviewed scientific publications and is a sought-after international speaker on topics including colostrum management, calf immunity, nutrition, and early-life management strategies. In addition, he has consulted with governmental agencies and industry organizations on issues related to calf health and performance.

In 1997, Dr. Quigley founded Calf Notes, an educational platform designed to translate complex scientific principles into clear, practical information for use on the farm. The resource has remained freely available since its inception and is used by producers, veterinarians, nutritionists, and advisors worldwide.

Through his work, Dr. Quigley continues to focus on improving calf health and performance by making science-based information accessible and applicable in real-world settings.
